How Three Testing Companies Can Change Your Family Tree

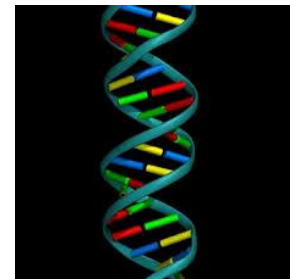
