Join us as Janet Brigham shares how to get the most from FamilySearch.org, the largest free genealogy website on the Internet. Through FamilySearch, you can research billions of records in the vast FamilySearch holdings, including the largest collection of international records. There are also numerous tutorials and videos. The FamilySearch Wiki provides research guidance and detailed help. FamilySearch Family Tree provides a collaborative online tree with places for recorded stories and digitized images. Users can borrow microfilms and microfiche of records listed in the FamilySearch catalog for a small fee to cover shipping costs to a specific Family History Center.



Janet Brigham is a research psychologist and genealogy enthusiast with a background in writing and editing and degrees in journalism and communications. She is vice president of the Silicon Valley Computer Genealogy Group and frequently teaches genealogy classes. She is editor of the *PastFinder* newsletter, which has been named best genealogy newsletter in the U.S. by the National Genealogical Society. She is married to Richard Rands, a professional genealogist.
