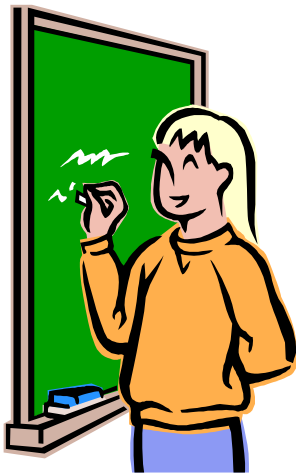




The Santa Clara County Historical and Genealogical Society presents:
