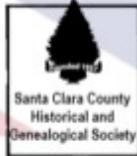

Mayflower descendent, author, family historian, and genealogical researcher, Bill Cole's research exploits include uncovering his previously unknown English ancestors whose children emigrated to America during the Great Puritan Migration to New England from 1620-1640. Bill recently co-chaired two international family history conferences and served six years as vice president of a large USA-based society with international members. Bill's book, *Puritans, Plagues, and Promises*, is based on 8+ years of English research. Its planned release is in early 2023.
