Competency of Enumerators

Not necessarily well educated or qualified for the job Poor penmanship Got the job from connections, not merit Low wages

Language Barriers

U.S. has always been home to a large number of immigrants, and those who do not speak English

Names were misunderstood, misspelled and thus difficult or impossible to find in indexes


Pfeiffer could easily become **Fifer Menkalski** was interpreted as **McKalsky** by an Irish Census taker in Cleveland in the 1920 Census

A significant portion of the American population could not read or write in the nineteenth century so misspellings stayed that way.
